## WHITE

**2021 MEURSAULT IER CRU 'LES GENEVRIÈRES', DAVID MORET ..... 260**  
Burgundy, France

*Located in the heart of the Côte de Beaune, this Premier Cru site produces Chardonnay that combines richness with finesse, and this vintage is no exception.*

*Aromas of ripe peach, pear, and citrus, intertwined with delicate floral notes and a subtle whiff of smoke from the oak aging.*

*On the palate, the wine is medium-bodied with a vibrant, mineral backbone that is characteristic of the terroir and fruit profile of green apple, lemon zest, and a touch of pineapple.*

**2022 ROUSSANNE VIEILLES VIGNES, CHÂTEAU DE BEAUCASTEL ..... 320**  
Southern Rhône, France

*A strikingly elegant white wine that highlights the unique qualities of this grape variety from the renowned Château de Beaucastel estate in Châteauneuf-du-Pape.*

*Medium to full-bodied, with flavours of ripe pear, citrus, and a hint of melon are complemented by layers of toasted almonds and a light touch of vanilla from the wine's oak aging. There's a beautiful minerality that runs through the wine, providing freshness and a clean, almost saline finish.*

## RED

### 2009 CHÂTEAU LYNCH-BAGES, 5ÈME CRU CLASSÉ, CHÂTEAU LYNCH-BAGES ..... 380 Bordeaux, France

*The Château Lynch-Bages 2009 is a magnificent expression of Pauillac, showcasing the depth and power that have made this estate one of the most revered in Bordeaux.*

*Aromas of ripe blackcurrant, plum, and cassis, underscored by classic Pauillac notes of tobacco, graphite, and cedar. A full-bodied wine, with a powerful yet refined structure. Dark berries, black cherries, and a touch of liquorice dominate, while secondary flavours of tobacco, roasted coffee, and graphite add depth.*

### 2015 CLOS DE LA ROCHE GRAND CRU, JEAN-CLAUDE BOISSET ..... 430 Burgundy, France

*A breathtaking example of Grand Cru Pinot Noir from one of Burgundy's most prestigious vineyard sites, Clos de la Roche in the heart of the Côte de Nuits.*

*The nose is an alluring mix of ripe black cherries, wild strawberries, and a bouquet of floral notes, intertwined with complex hints of spice, earth, and subtle oak. Flavours of blackcurrant and blackberry, enhanced by layers of spice, leather, and a touch of chocolate. A long, persistent finish with mineral undertones and a hint of smoke.*

### 2010 SASSICAIA, TENUTA SAN GUIDO ..... 520 Tuscany, Italy

*The Sassicaia 2018 is a stunning expression of Tuscany's most renowned red wine, showcasing the exceptional quality of the Bolgheri terroir.*

*A blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc, offering a deep, intense ruby colour in the glass. Aromas of ripe blackberries, cassis, and plums, complemented by herbal notes of rosemary, sage, and a subtle touch of bell pepper, a signature of the Cabernet Franc.*

*Medium to full-bodied with a beautifully balanced structure. Its fine tannins provide a smooth yet firm backbone, and a vibrant freshness. With nuances of spices, leather, and a touch of minerality. The finish is long, precise, and refined, with lingering notes of dark chocolate and a slight herbal edge.*

### 2000 CARRUADES DE LAFITE, CHATEAU LAFITE ROTHSCHILD, PAUILLAC ..... 585 Bordeaux, France

*A deep garnet colour and a nose full of ripe blackcurrant, plum, and cassis, layered with notes of graphite, cigar box, and subtle oak spice. On the palate, it offers impressive depth, with fine-grained tannins and a balanced structure. Hints of blackberry, tobacco, leather, and a touch of mocha unfold over time, leading into a smooth, persistent finish with earthy undertones.*

*Now in its prime, the 2000 Carruades delivers a harmonious blend of maturity and vitality, offering both complexity and drinkability. It's a superb choice for those looking to experience the character of Lafite in a more approachable and nuanced form.*
